

Creating a Flickr account and uploading photos (available to the public)

To create a Flickr account:

1. Visit <https://www.flickr.com/>
2. Click 'Sign up' and fill out the information requested.
3. Click 'Send activation key'. You will receive a 5 digit key at the email you provided earlier. Fill in this key and click 'Activate' then 'Let's get started'
4. You can choose to secure your account with your phone number or click 'I'll secure my account later'. This will bring you to Flickr home page.

To upload a photo and create a link:

1. At the top left corner of the page next to the Flickr logo, hover over 'You' and select 'Albums'
2. This will bring you to your Albums page. Click 'Go to Camera Roll', then 'Select files to upload'
3. Once uploaded, it will bring you to your 'Camera Roll'
 - a. In the bottom left corner of every photo there is a small lock, click this and select 'Public' for each one. ***If you skip this step, people will not be able to see your project photos!***
4. Click on the photo so that it is enlarged on the screen.
5. Towards the bottom right corner, you will find the download button (It looks like an underlined downward arrow).
 - a. When you click this button, a small menu will pop up with different download sizes. Right click on 'Small (240x180)' and click 'Copy link address.'
6. Return to the Monarch Conservation Activity Submission Form and paste the link in the photo section.
